

Job Description

Our team at Wonderfully Made is looking for 2 full-time teachers for our new 4-year-old classroom, known as The Pioneers. The Pioneers classroom consists of 20 children in total. Each teacher will be assigned his or her own group of 10 children to oversee and support in their learning. Though the children get to collectively spend time together, teachers also get to connect with their assigned students one-on-one and as a small group during circle times. The Pioneers enjoy two separate outdoor play times in the morning. This allows children who need the physical outlet to get outdoors before settling down to learn while the other children enjoy a quieter learning space during their morning activities. A shared outdoor play time is held in the afternoon.

We believe in the teaching that *good leaders eat last*. That is why both our Director and Assistant Director at Wonderfully Made frequently serve their teachers with daily tasks like bathroom duty and clean ups so that our teachers are able to spend more quality time with their students. As author Simon Sinek once said, "If your actions inspire others to dream more, learn more, do more and become more, you are a leader". Our heart is to find passionate early education teachers whom we can provide a safe space to grow and a work that they find joy in doing.

Our school is open Monday to Friday from 7AM to 5PM. Full-time staff work 8-hour shifts and 40-hour weeks Monday through Friday. Pay is \$19/hour.
